Shoot Program

- Range is open Friday afternoon before the shoot for practice. We'll start shooting sighters at 9:30 a.m. Saturday with
 matches starting at 10:00. You need to arrive well before 9:30 to set up. Do not post sighters until instructed to by
 match officials.
- We will shoot ten 1-shot matches in succession with no break.
- World Championship title, prizes and trophy awarded to the shooter with the shortest 10 shot string.

Rules

- Muzzle loading guns of very traditional chunk or hunting style and design only. Open fixed sights only; the rear sight must be at least 6" from the breech end of the barrel. Black powder or black powder substitute with cloth patched round balls only. No false muzzles. No in-line actions or sealed ignitions. No roll-over cheek pieces, pistol grips, thumbhole stocks, composition or laminated stocks, composition butt plates, schuetzen style or hooked butt plates, or adjustable butt plates. No butt stocks with radical knobs, swells or relief cuts, or that are deeper than 6" from heel to toe. No modern coil spring under hammer actions "buggy rifle" under hammers are allowed. The Bevel Brothers will inspect each gun; their decisions on acceptability are final. If you have any doubt that your gun may not be seen as traditional in our eyes you had best bring an alternate that you are sure will be.
- Some chunks will be provided, but we recommend you bring your own. The matches will go faster if everyone has their own chunk and does not attempt to share spaces at the line. Bring your own mat and sighter.
- Spotting scopes are allowed. Wind flags are allowed if their placement does not interfere with other shooters, but that
 is almost impossible except at the far edges of the range. No target shaders or personal shaders/umbrellas/pop-ups
 at the firing line. No coaching except for junior shooters.
- Sandbags allowed for chunk rest only. Butt stock must be supported by the shooters body only and may not touch the
 ground. No padded shooting gloves or any other kind of glove unless it's darn cold. No support on top of or beneath
 the mat, including blanket folds, heaped up dirt or handy rocks.
