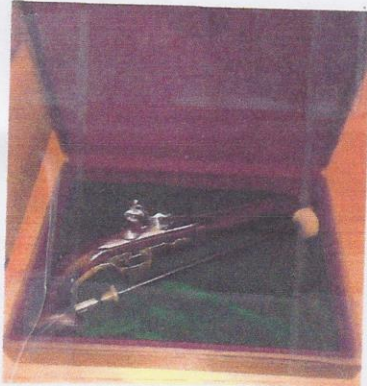


**IOWA BLACK POWDER FEDERATION**

**MOUNTAIN MEN AND HAWKEN RIFLES**  
200TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE HAWKEN RIFLE

**A rare find!** A small number of original, colored lithographs of John Barsotti's famous oil painting titled, *Mountain Men and Hawken Rifles* (copyrighted 1963) **have** been discovered and made available to NMLRA. John Barsotti was a historian and artist from Columbus, Ohio who frequented Bull Ramsey's Last Chance Hotel at Friendship in the 1950's. He would often do a pencil drawing of you, and hang it in the Last Chance Hotel if you were wanted by the proprietors of the Last change Hotel for unpaid services. John Barsotti allowed NMLRA to sell offset prints of it in the 1960 and 1970's. Here is one last chance to own copy of this print. It will be our second item available in our IBPF raffle.
